Programme “Perspektive Aufstieg” (PPA) SoSe 2026

Application period starts on 24.11.2025 until 23.01.2026

- **The programme consists of three essential parts:**

1. **Language component:**

→ B2, C1

2. **Integration (“Glückauf!”)**

→ Different events/seminars/workshops (for example discussion groups, Guided tours and many more)

3. **Field of Studies**

→ from B2 onwards: participation in lectures, seminars, tutorials for “standard students”

→ possibility to take exams and count the credits towards your academic achievements when re-registering for your course of studies

- **The German courses will start on 30.03.2026.**

- Weekly classes:

B1 and B2: 15 teaching hours, C1: 20 teaching hours

- Schedules are different for every course. You will be assigned to a class about three weeks before the start of the courses.

- Student ID/ Deutschlandticket costs about 240 Euro per semester.

The German courses are free.

- From C1 onwards it is possible that the PPA bears the costs for one of these official language exams: DSH / Telc C1 Hochschule / TestDaF / C1 Goethe

Requirements for participation

- International prospective students with or without Refugee status
- Proof of Higher Education Entrance Qualification (Abitur) abroad which would allow you to study there
- Intention to study at the Technische Hochschule Georg Agricola
- Participation in the German-placement test (“Einstufungstest”) of the PPA

How can I apply?

These are the steps for application:

1. Please send us the following documents as a PDF in one email to:

- High school diploma in the original language and translated into German or English
- Residence permit (front and back) or identity card and, if applicable, visa
- Current CV
- If available: Academic records (grade transcript, degree certificate)
in the original language and translated into German or English
- If available: Language certificate from the last successfully completed German course

2. We will review your documents.

3. If your documents are complete and you meet the requirements,
we will send you an online consultation appointment.

4. After your registration, you will be invited to an online German placement test.

The test determines the language level you can attend in our program.

5. Once you have received the results of the German placement test, you decide
whether you want to accept the place in the program.
