### Programme “Perspektive Aufstieg“ (PPA) WS 2026/27

Application period starts on 26.05.2026 until 17.07.2026

- **The programme consists of three essential parts:**

1. **Language**

→ Expected levels B2, C1

2. **Integration** (“Glückauf!”)

→ Different events/seminars/workshops (for example discussion groups, Guided tours and many more)

3. **Field of Studies**

→ from B2 onwards: participation in lectures, seminars, tutorials for “standard students”

→ possibility to take exams and count the credits towards your academic achievements when re-registering for your course of studies

- **The German courses will start on 28.09.2026**

- Weekly classes:

B2: 15 teaching hours, C1: 20 teaching hours

- Schedules are different for every course. You will be assigned to a class about three weeks before the start of the courses.

- Student ID/ Deutschlandticket costs about 240 Euro per semester.

The German courses are free.

- From C1 onwards it is possible that the PPA bears the costs for one of these official language exams: DSH / Telc C1 Hochschule / TestDaF / C1 Goethe

### **Requirements for participation**

- International prospective students with or without Refugee status
- Proof of Higher Education Entrance Qualification (Abitur) abroad which would allow you to study there
- Intention to study at the Technische Hochschule Georg Agricola
- Participation in the German-placement test (“Einstufungstest”) of the PPA

## **How can I apply?**

These are the steps for application:

  - Secondary school leaving certificate (Abitur) in the original language and translated into German or English
  - Residence permit (front and back) or ID card and, if applicable, visa
  - Current CV including your current address and mobile phone number
  - If available: proof of previous studies (transcript of records, university degree certificate) in the original language and translated into German or English
  - If available: language certificate from the last successfully completed German course
2. We will review your documents.
3. If your documents are complete and you meet the requirements, we will send you an appointment for an online consultation.
4. After your registration, you will be invited to take an online German placement test. This test determines the language level you can attend in our program.
5. After receiving the result of the German placement test, you can decide whether you would like to accept the place in the program.
